Our time with Pastor Foote and his church was a great blessing. Pastor Foote and his wife took us to the Iron Mills Farmstead. We had a great time!

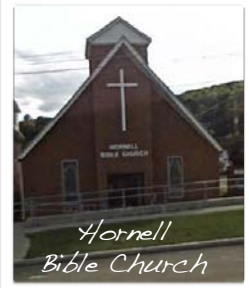

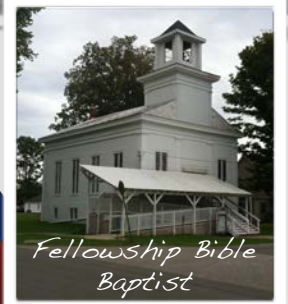

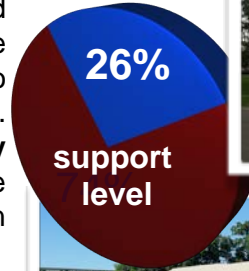
